Who is Young Water Professionals Denmark?

The purpose of Young Water Professionals Denmark (YWPDK) is to provide a free of charge and non-profit networking platform for young water professionals in the Danish water sector through regional, national, and international engagement activities. YWPDK focus on professional networking, knowledge sharing, skills development, exploring new trends and encourage international collaboration.



YWPDK is the biggest group of young water professionals and students in the Danish water sector, ranging from social, natural, and engineering, policymakers, scholars, and practitioners. Our members are diverse and is made up of Danish nationals, and internationals.



Network Partnership


